Please note the following for Instructional support services:

- **Elementary – learning packets and technology devices;** after the week of the 23rd, Elementary will no longer be providing learning packets. All learning will transition to online. Communication with your child's teacher through remind or email is imperative.
- **Secondary - virtual and online learning.** Communication with your child's teacher through remind or email is imperative. You must accept ALL invites to your google classrooms and students/parents please accept ALL REMIND invites. Students, please check your gmail account for invites.

Learning packets or technology devices, that have been requested, will be picked up between the hours of 8:30 – 4:30 on Monday, March 23rd in front of the Elementary and High School. Everyone is asked to remain in their vehicle.

**This is the only day to receive all materials.*

This is a drive by service to be provided; if you have any questions or concerns we kindly ask that you contact your child's campus via phone or email. In order to make this service what it is meant to be, a precautionary measure taken to keep from coming in contact with the virus, please know in advance that questions will not be answered while you're picking up your child(s) learning materials.

Also, during our school closure, Riviera ISD will offer free curbside meals beginning on Tuesday, March 24th through April 17th, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. The to-go breakfast and lunch meals can be picked up in front of the cafeteria. *Again, we ask that you stay in your vehicles and we will bring the meals to you.*
